The month of December in reality was much different than we had initially planned; in that way, it resembled all of 2020. While we wanted to be in Texas and the US to see family, friends, and supporters, the Covid–19 situation in Singapore simply did not and does not allow that. Beyond just not being able to travel far, we were not even able to get across the border to help with the camp in Malaysia like last year as even the local borders are closed. In all of these changes and cancellations, we have found plenty of work in December locally. As the month and year comes to a conclusion, we want to extend a final 2020 thank you to all of you who have supported, encouraged, sent care packages, mailed Christmas cards, and more. We thank you and we thank God for you all!

FOUR SEAS BIBLE COLLEGE

Since the borders are closed, none of the students could leave during this time to visit their home or to work on internships. Instead, they attended classes in personal development each day Monday – Thursday with occasional Saturday classes. During the morning they had different instructors each day with different topics to help them become better Christians, Bible students, ministers, missionaries, and people. I taught classes over Greek, mission reports, and writing research papers. Lisa taught the Ladies class over modesty and personal conduct becoming Christian women. We had local instructors from Singapore, Malaysia, Australia, and Philippines. We also had few instructors who taught the courses from the USA. We are so grateful for the technology that made this available and the willingness of brethren to teach these classes over personal development. Each afternoon the students had an English class followed by World Video Bible School videos and corresponding assignments. I coordinated the afternoon sessions.

On Fridays the students were able to get off campus for various outings. They were supported by local brethren for these outings which was quite a blessing. On almost each outing, our family had the opportunity to accompany them and provide any assistance needed. Unfortunately, we could not mingle between groups as the maximum group size was 5 people (that has now been changed to 8 people).

In less than a week we will begin the new school year. I will be teaching Old Testament Survey, Job-Song of Solomon, and English Grammar I during the 1st half of the 1st term. We will have 11 second year students, 2 first year students (both local Singaporeans because of border/Covid issues), and 1 wrap around student. If the Covid restrictions loosen and travel becomes easier, we look forward to students from India, Philippines, and Laos who have already been admitted for this school year. We solicit your prayers that these individuals who long to study and teach God's word will be able to come to Singapore and study at Four Seas.

Because of some of the restrictions on gatherings, we have been able to have a few people from the congregation and other congregations in Singapore over to our house this month. A maximum of 5 (now 8) can visit which made us visiting other people and places very difficult because we are a family of 6.

As the door closes on 2020, we know that the door opens on 2021. If you have studied the concept of an "open door" in the New Testament, you know that it is most often used with the opportunities of evangelism. We look forward to "open doors" in 2021 and hope you will too!
